- Liaise with other Benefices in the Deanery who have identified "engaging with youth and teenagers " as an area of "best practice", in order to ascertain how/if we can utilise their experience and expertise. (Benefice DMPC representatives)
- Explore with St Barnabas, Weeke, the possibility of developing a model for future cooperation in the ministry for teenagers. Also identify a church, located closer to them, with whom Chilbolton and Wherwell could cooperate. (Benefice Council).

Autumn 2020

- Review BFCC's identified priorities and appoint Working Group (to include BFCC) to implement these . (Benefice Council)
- Commence implementation of BFCC priorities. (Working Group and PCCs)
- Establish working group to develop St Barnabas and A N Other church initiative. (Benefice Council)

- More Worship Leaders and Pastoral Missioners identified, trained, and "put into action".
 - More SSMs and retired priests working with the Benefice Ministry team.
 - Acceptance by the Benefice Council and PCCs of a new resource and service pattern structure that
 - meets our needs.

Spring 2019

- Promote Diocese BCM programmes across the Benefice. (ongoing by Benefice Council)
- Identify and select candidates for training using BCM programme.
 (ongoing by Incumbent utilising Diocese for training)
- Ongoing-be ever alert to the opportunity to persuade SSMs and retired clergy to work with the Benefice ministry team
- Appoint a Working Group (team) to review current and likely future ministry team resources; also Benefice and Parish service patterns. (Benefice Council)

Summer 2019

- Meet with Incumbent and Benefice Office Administrator to establish team objectives, and ascertain available ministry team resources and current service patterns. (Working Group)
- Review possible options, and prepare recommendations. (Working Group)

Autumn 2019

- Submit recommendations to Incumbent, Benefice Council and PCCs for review. (Working Group)
- Responses from Incumbent, Benefice Council and PCCs to be considered, and Recommendation to be amended, if required, and resubmitted. (Working Group)
- Final agreed Recommendation to be presented to Parish congregations and implementation date agreed.

Spring 2020

• Agreed Recommendation implemented on 1st Feb.
