Independent examiner's report to the PCC of St Mary the Less, Chilbolton

This report on the financial statements of the PCC for the year ending 31 December 2017, which are set out on pages 1-5, is in respect of an examination carried out in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 ("the Regulations") and section 133 of the Charities Act 2011 ("the Act").

Repective responsibilties of the PCC and the examiner

As members of the PCC you are responsible for the preparation of the financial statements. You consider that the audit requirements of the Regulations and section 144(1) of the Act do not apply. It is my responsibility to issue this report on those financial statements in accordance with the terms of the Regulations.

Basis of this report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity

Commission under section 130 of the Act and to be found in the 2013 edition of *PCC Accountability* issued by the Finance Division of the Archbishops' Council. That examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the PCC and a comparison of the accounts with those records. It also includes considering any unusual items or disclosures in the financial statements and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence

that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by

the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement

In connection with my examination, no matter has come to my attention:

(1) which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect the following two requirements

have not been met:

- (a) to keep accounting records in accordance with section 43 of the Act and
- (b) to prepare financial statements which accord with the accounting records and comply with the requirements of the Act and the Regulations
- (2) to which, in my opinion, attention should be drawn in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached
