### There is a lot to praise God for and give thanks for.....

- Becky Edwards and the team from Holy Trinity Church, Richmond had a very productive time visiting their link church St Peter's, Wandegye in **February** and they thank everybody so much for praying for them.



- Whilst there they joined with a team from St Peter's and the diocese to welcome 87 young children from Katanga to learn about "Sitting at the feet of Jesus" through the story of Martha and Mary, with drama, lots of craft, crazy games and action songs.
- We thank God for the team's ministry to St Peter's and the community of Katanga through leading, speaking, supporting, encouraging and their compassion for the families they visited.

### We praise God for the end of 2017 exam results...

- All 27 Karis pupils who took their end of Primary school exams at the end of 2017 passed in the top 3 grades – the best results ever!
- 14 out of 15 of the Karis students taking their Uganda Certificate of Education (like GCSEs) consisting of 7 compulsory and 3 optional subjects passed; 7 have moved on to A level courses and 7 have started vocational training courses.
- The 7 students taking A Level courses are now applying for University courses or other vocational training courses.

Pray for clarity for all students as they make their subject choices whether at High School, University or Vocational College and for Ketrach and Solome as they counsel them.
