### Notes to accompany the accounts

- 1. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006, using the Receipts & Payments basis; investment assets are shown at market value as at 31st December 2022.
- 2. Despite there being insufficient funds to meet the full Common Mission Fund commitment, no shares were sold from the General Fund as the fall in value of the shares precluded this option. So no funds were withdrawn from Reserves.
- 3. The balance on the Current account according to the bank statement as at 31st December 2022 was £5,231.78. This sum, plus a late credit of £260.00, gives Current account funds available of £5,491.78.
- 4. Funds The cash element of all the funds is kept within the PCC bank account.
- a) The Churchyard Fund is mainly an endowment which requires the income to be spent on maintaining the churchyard.
- b) The Restricted Fund represents funds donated by the FOSS, and others, which are used to meet payments as specified by the donors.
- c) The Bell Fund is a designated fund which represents funds raised/donated by the Bellringers and is used to meet bell-related payments.

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#### PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL OF ST.STEPHEN'S CHURCH, SPARSHOLT WITH LAINSTON

- The Agency Fund is used when the PCC has collected money on behalf of someone else, for example church collections for specified charities. This year, £225.20 was the Remembrance Service collection which, together with Gift Aid on this collection of £56.30, made a total of £281.50 which was paid to SSAFA The Armed Forces Charity. As this was collected on behalf of SSAFA, these figures are not included in the PCC's accounts. Likewise, 4 Funeral Collections, of £116.08, 161.45, £15.00 and £182.50 were paid to charities via the Agency Fund. Also, School Collections in aid of charity of £306.64 and £685.00 were paid via the Agency Fund.
- The BB (Buckston Browne) Fund and BenAug (Benefice Augmentation) Fund are Endowments administered by the PCC on behalf the Vicar and Churchwardens of St. Stephen's, Sparsholt and do not form part of the assets of the PCC. Income is used in accordance with the Trust Deeds.
- 5. The following assets are recognised but not necessarily valued in the Statement of Assets and Liabilities: Movable church furnishings held by the Churchwardens on special trust for the PCC and which require a faculty for disposal.
- 6. The expenses paid to the clergy may include a small immaterial proportion, which relates to their functions as PCC members. The only other payments made to PCC members were in relation to expenses incurred in church running expenses and cost of services.

### Independent examiner's report to the Members/Trustees of St. Stephen's, Sparsholt with Lainston, Parochial Church Council

This report on the accounts of the PCC for the year ended 31 December 2022, which are set out on pages 1 to 5 is in respect of an examination carried out in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 ('the Regulations') and s.145 of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').

## Respective responsibilities of the Trustees and the Independent Examiner

The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed. It is my responsibility to:

- examine the accounts under section 145 of the 2011 Act;
- follow the procedures laid down in the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners section 145(5)(b) of the 2011 Act; and
- state whether any particular matters have come to my attention.

### **Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement**

My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commission. I have no conflict of interest in relation to this examination.

An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the PCC and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeking explanations from the executive committee concerning any such matters. The

procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in a full audit, and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a 'true and fair view' and the report is limited to those matters set out in the statement below.

### Independent Examiner's Statement
